KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

As per office report, respondent has been served through counsel before the trial Court. But no representation has been made on behalf of respondent. Hence, proceeded against ex-parte.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 10 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as “**Rupinder Singh vesus Seema Rani**” pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Patiala to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that two cases between the parties are already pending at Jalandhar Courts. It is further stated that earlier respondent had filed a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and when the petitioner put in appearance, the same was withdrawn on 20.9.2016. Now fresh petition has been filed.

Considering the fact that two cases are already pending between the parties at Jalandhar Courts; the fact that none has appeared to oppose the petition and in order to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties should be tried at one place, petition filed under Section 10 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as **“Rupinder Singh vesus Seema Rani”** pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Patiala is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Jalandhar, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.
