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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Heard.

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that maternal aunt is relation of husband of petitioner.

Petitioner seeks transfer of civil suit, titled as *Kanta Munjal Versus Deepika alias Simran and others*, pending in Court of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurugram, to Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Karnal.

It comes out that respondent has filed a civil suit for permanent injunction against present petitioner and others for restraining them from defaming plaintiff-respondent by way of filing suit, application, complaint, publication and oral speech. It also comes out that present petitioner has

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also filed a complaint against plaintiff-respondent and others under Section 12 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, at Gurugram Courts. Plaintiff-respondent is maternal aunt of husband of petitioner. Karnal Courts and Gurugram Courts are connected by National Highway. It is a civil case, in which petitioner is not required to appear on each and every date of hearing. There is no ground to transfer case, titled as *Kanta Munjal Versus Deepika alias Simran and others*, from Gurugram Courts to Karnal Courts. Consequently, petition is dismissed.
