Petitioner seeks transfer of petition i.e. HMA No. 449 of 2017, titled as *Jaswinder Kumar Versus Bhinder Kaur*, filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Sangrur, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Bathinda. It is stated that application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is pending before learned Civil Judge, Phul. No litigation is pending at Bathinda Courts. It comes out that petitioner belongs to Rampura Mandi which is at a distance of little more than 30 kilometers from Bathinda. From Rampura Mandi, Sangrur is about 70 kilometers. There is four lane road. In either case, petitioner will have to go from Bathinda to Sangrur. The plea that petitioner has two minor children is no ground as even for going to Bathinda Courts, she will have to leave the children at home. In these circumstances, there is no ground to transfer the case from Sangrur Courts to Bathinda Courts. Consequently, petition is dismissed.
