Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1955, titled as “*Rupinder Singh vs Baljeet Kaur*”, pending in the court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Amritsar, to a court of competent jurisdiction at Gurdaspur.

Respondent is served for today but none has appeared on his behalf.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that two other cases of the parties are also pending at District Courts, Gurdaspur, in which respondent is appearing through his counsel.

Considering the facts and circumstances, petition filed under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1955, titled as “*Rupinder Singh*

vs Baljeet Kaur”, pending in the court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Amritsar, is withdrawn from his/her court and transferred to the court of learned District Judge, Gurdaspur, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to a court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
