Respondent has not appeared, despite service.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908 for transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Hoshiarpur to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

It is stated that the petitioner has got five years old daughter who is studying at Ludhiana, so she cannot frequently go to the Court at Hoshiarpur to pursue her petition.

Keeping in view the difficulty expressed on behalf of the petitioner, petition titled as “*Baljeet Bassi vs. Mrs. Sameep*”, filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Hoshiarpur, is withdrawn from the said

Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Ludhiana, who may retain the case himself or entrust the same to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
