Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

Respondent has not appeared despite service. He is proceeded against ex-parte.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 25 of Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 by the respondent titled as *Randeep Singh vs. Navneet Kaur* pending in the Court of learned Guardian Judge, Tarn Taran to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that case is filed for the custody of the minor son Eknoor Singh @ Dharuv. The said minor is residing with the petitioner at Amritsar. Under Section 9 of Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, jurisdiction is with the Court where the minor is residing.

Accordingly, the petition filed under Section 25 of Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 by the respondent titled as *Randeep Singh vs. Navneet Kaur* pending in the Court of learned Guardian Judge, Tarn Taran is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned Guardian Judge, Amritsar.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
