1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Respondent has not appeared, despite service. He be proceeded against ex parte.

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Kuljit Singh vs Manpreet Kaur*”, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Khanna, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Malerkotla.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has got 3½ years minor school going child. It is also stated that two other litigation between the parties are pending at Malerkotla Court.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner and to ensure that all the litigation pending between the parties should be tried and decided at one place, the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Kuljit Singh vs Manpreet Kaur*”, pending in

the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Khanna, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Malerkotla.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
