The copy of the order dated 27.04.2018 passed by learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Rajpura, has also been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Though, the village Karala was transferred from Sub Division Rajpura to Sub Division Dera Bassi, but the suit which was pending at Rajpura Courts, was fixed for evidence of the defendant. It is further pointed out that despite the order dated 26.04.2018 passed by this Court directing the trial Court to proceed with the matter without considering whether it has territorial jurisdiction or not, the plaint was returned vide order dated 27.04.2018 by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Rajpura.

Both the parties are now agreed that the case may be tried at Rajpura Courts.

Considering the said fact, the order dated 27.04.2018 passed by learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Rajpura, returning the plaint is set aside and the suit titled as “*Randhir Singh vs Mohan Singh and others*” stands specifically entrusted to Court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Rajpura, for disposal, in accordance with law.

As such, the present petition is disposed of.
