This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908 for transfer of the petition titled as '***Amit Malik vs. Geetu Bala***' filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Hoshiarpur to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Moga (Punjab).

It is stated that petitioner is a household lady and belongs to Dharamkot, District Moga and a petition filed under Section 125 of the Criminal Procedure Code is pending before the District Judge, Family Court, Moga (Punjab). Therefore, it is requested that all the cases should be tried at one place.
