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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition titled as *Amandeep Singh Versus Mandeep Kaur*, filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, to any other Court of competent jurisdiction at Moga.

It is stated that execution of order passed on an application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is pending at Sri Muktsar Sahib Courts. Copy of petition has been filed which shows that parties last resided at Moga and most of witnesses belong to Sri Muktsar Sahib. Therefore, there will be inconvenience to witnesses also in case, if the case is transferred to Moga Courts. The petitioner can be compensated with expenses for travelling to Sri Muktsar Sahib, whenever she attends case. However, it is ordered that

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respondent shall pay Rs. 2,000/- as travelling expenses whenever petitioner appears before Sri Muktsar Sahib Courts. Otherwise also, it is a civil case in which personal appearance of petitioner is not required on each and every date of hearing. Consequently, petition is dismissed. Since main case has been dismissed, therefore, pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
