The petitioner(wife) has filed this transfer application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of case under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled 'Dinkar Sehgal vs. Latika Sehgal', filed by the respondent(husband), which is presently pending at District Courts, Chandigarh to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is residing with her parents at Patiala. The respondent is an ex-Army man and is presently employed as Data Entry Operator in Punjab School Education Board, Mohali whereas the petitioner is a housewife. Three cases namely a complaint under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC filed by the petitioner against the respondent, a case under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. are pending before the Court at Patiala and the respondent is appearing in those cases. Learned counsel states that it is very difficult for the petitioner to attend the Court proceedings at Chandigarh, which is about 80 KM from Patiala.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed. The case under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled 'Dinkar Sehgal vs. Latika Sehgal', filed by the respondent (husband), which is presently pending at District Courts, Chandigarh is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to Patiala. The District Judge, Patiala may assign it to any competent Court.
