Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Sunil Kumar vs Jyoti*”, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Kapurthala, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Moga.

It is stated that a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. between the parties is also pending at District Courts, Moga. The petitioner has got minor child and cannot go to Kapurthala to attend the court.

In view of the difficulty expressed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Sunil Kumar vs Jyoti*”, pending in the Court of learned

District Judge, Kapurthala, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the court of learned District Judge, Moga, who may retain the case himself/herself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.
