The petitioner-wife has filed this petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transferring the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as "Gurpreet Singh Vs. Manpreet Kaur", filed by the respondent-husband, which is pending in the Court of Ld. District Judge, Patiala, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is residing at Village Sherpur, Tehsil Dhuri, District Sangrur. There is no one in the family who can accompany the petitioner to attend the court proceedings at Patiala.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the parties agreed that the case may be transferred from Patiala to Sangrur, which would be at an equal distance from the place of residence of the petitioner as Barnala.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this petition is allowed.

The petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as “Gurpreet Singh Vs. Manpreet Kaur”, filed by the respondent-husband, which is pending in the Court of Ld. District Judge, Patiala is withdrawn from that Court and transferred to Sangrur. The District Judge, Sangrur may assign it to any competent Court.
