Reply filed on behalf of respondent is taken on record.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as **“Gurpreet Singh versus Amanpreet Kaur”** (Annexure P-1) pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Patiala to the Court of learned District Judge, Ludhiana.

Heard.

It comes out that the petitioner belongs to Khanna and distance between Khanna and Ludhiana is approximately 45 Kms whereas between Khanna and Patiala is approximately 55 KMs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has got one minor daughter. She is totally dependent on the income of parents and her parents are ill.

Whatever the case may be, petitioner will have to travel either to Ludhiana or to Patiala to pursue her case.

Since the distance is almost the same, no ground to transfer the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as **“Gurpreet Singh versus Amanpreet Kaur”** (Annexure P-1) pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Patiala to the Court of learned District Judge, Ludhiana is made out.

However, the plea of the petitioner that she has no source of income to pursue her case at Patiala Courts can be met by directing the respondent to pay Rs. 1,000/- on each and every date of appearance of the petitioner before the Patiala Courts.

With the above noted direction, petition is dismissed.
