Respondent has been served but none has come present on his behalf. He is proceeded against ex parte.

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition bearing No.HMA/49/2015, filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “***Mukul Goyal vs Pooja Rani***”, pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Kurukshetra, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at S.A.S. Nagar Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that two other cases between the parties are pending at Dera Bassi Courts, District S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali.

Considering the said fact that all the cases pending between the parties are to be tried at one place, the petition bearing No.HMA/49/2015, filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “***Mukul Goyal vs Pooja Rani***”, pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr.

Divn.), Kurukshetra, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Dera Bassi.

As such, the present petition is allowed.

Since, the main petition has been allowed, therefore, the pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
