Reply on behalf of the respondent filed in Court is taken on record.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Arshdeep Singh vs. Amarjit Kaur* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Jalandhar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. are already pending at Ludhiana Courts. Earlier respondent had filed a petition under Section 10 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, which was transferred by this Court vide order dated 27.10.2016 (Annexure P2) passed in TA-636-2016. Thereafter, the said petition was dismissed for non-prosecution. Now, fresh petition has been filed. It is

further stated that the petitioner has got 5 years old minor daughter and she cannot pursue her case at Jalandhar Courts.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner, petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Arshdeep Singh vs. Amarjit Kaur* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Jalandhar is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned District Judge, Ludhiana, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
