Father of the respondent refused service, which is deemed to be a proper service.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing no.HMA 103 of 2016 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Rahul Kumar Verma vs. Gita Verma* from the Court of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Sangrur.

It is contended that it is difficult for the petitioner to go on each and every date of hearing at Chandigarh to pursue her case.

Keeping in view the difficulty explained by the petitioner, petition bearing no.HMA 103 of 2016 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Rahul Kumar Verma vs. Gita Verma* pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sangrur.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
