Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing no.HMA/75/2017 dated 03.07.2017 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Harvinder Singh vs. Rajinder Kaur* pending before the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Abohar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Barnala

It is stated that the distance between two places is 170 kms. Petitioner is resident of village Dhanaula, which is between Barnala and Sangrur.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner, petition bearing no.HMA /75/2017 dated 03.07.2017 filed under Section 9 of Hindu
