This is an application for transfer the divorce petition filed by the husband titled as Dr. Sukant Varma vs. Neelu in the Court of Additional District Judge, Jalandhar to the court of competent jurisdiction at Hisar.

The ground taken by the counsel for the applicant is that the applicant is single woman without any source of income and distance between Hisar and Jalandhar is 300 K.M. approximately. Moreover, three criminal cases have been filed at Hisar by the applicant against the respondent and the respondent is already attending those cases. Counsel for the respondent has argued that in fact the respondent is facing immense problem in defending cases at Hisar and filed an transfer application in this Court in which further proceedings have been stayed and those cases are fixed for 28.2.2019. Counsel for the applicant has countered this argument

by stating that respondent has filed two other cases at Jalandhar also and transfer applications in those cases has also been filed in this Court.

Today, on instructions from their client who are present in the Court both the learned counsel has agreed that all the cases between the parties should be transferred to the District Court, Jind and every time when the applicant-wife has to go to Jind she would be entitled to a sum of Rs. 1000/- as transportation charges. It has further been agreed that after transfer application, both the parties would be at liberty to move application/s before the competent Court/s for fix all the cases on one particular date, as far as possible, so that the mutual inconvenient is decreased. Both the parties will place this agreed order in the other transfer applications also.

In the circumstances, divorce petition filed by the husband titled as Dr. Sukant Varma vs. Neelu in the Court of Additional District Judge, Jalandhar is transferred to the Family Court at Jind. Let the record be sent there. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before Family Court at Jind on 20.12.2018. It has further been agreed that in every Court where the case is pending the respondent will deposit a sum of Rs.5000/- each to represent the transportation expenses which the applicant can claim every time she visits Jind. It is clarified that if the applicant visit Jind in more than one case on any particular date she will only get one Rs.1000/- for that visit.

Application stands disposed of.
