This transfer application has been filed by the applicant-wife to transfer two petitions filed by the respondent-husband one being petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and another being petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act from the District Court, Patiala to a competent Court at Jalandhar.

Counsel for the respondent states that the respondent wants to settle this dispute and therefore would not oppose the transfer of the case but prays that the matter be referred to mediation in the first instance.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act and the petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act filed by the respondent – husband is transferred to the District Judge and Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Jalandhar respectively. The record be sent to the respective courts.

Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the respective courts

on 27.12.2018. It is further directed that before proceeding further the District Judge refer the matter to mediation and would proceed further only after the report of the mediation centre.

Consequently, the transfer application stands allowed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
