The petitioner is the wife and the respondent her husband. This petition has been filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transferring of the case under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as “Jatin Vs. Isha Chawla pending in the Court of Ld. District Judge (Family Court), Hisar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with respondent on 27.02.2017. The respondent filed a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of the marriage at Hisar. He further states that the petitioner is residing at Karnal and the respondent is also residing at a place which is 20 kms. from Karnal. Hisar is at the distance of 200 kms. from Karnal. It is difficult for the petitioner to attend the Court proceeding at Hisar.

The respondent, who is present in Court in person states that he has no objection if the case is transferred from Hisar to Karnal.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this petition is allowed. The case filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as “Jatin Vs. Isha Chawla pending in the Court of Ld. District Judge (Family Court), Hisar is ordered to be transferred to Family Court at Karnal.
