Harinder Singh Sidhu, J.

The petitioner is the husband of the respondent. He has filed the present petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as 'Ankit Arora vs. Geetika Narula', filed by him, from the District Judge (Family Court) Moga to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

It is the case of the petitioner that the respondent has filed a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 at Ludhiana. In these circumstances, it would be appropriate that the petition under section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act be transferred to Ludhiana. It is further stated that a petition under Section 25 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 pending between the parties, has already been referred for mediation at Ludhiana.

In view thereof, by mutual consent of learned counsel for the parties, the transfer application is allowed.

The petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as 'Ankit Arora vs. Geetika Narula', filed by the petitioner, which is pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court) Moga is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to Ludhiana. The District Judge Ludhiana may assign it to any competent Court.
