Petitioner seeks transfer of petition, i.e. petition No. HMA/259/2017, titled as *Randhir Singh Virk Versus Natinder Kaur*, filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Faridkot, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It comes out that two cases between the parties, i.e. one under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and one FIR case, are already pending at Sri Muktsar Sahib Courts. Present petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage

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Act, 1955, is pending before learned District Judge, Family Court, Faridkot. Though, there is distance of only 35 kilometers between Faridkot and Sri Muktsar Sahib, however, in order to ensure that all pending cases between parties should be tried at one place, petition i.e. petition No. HMA/259/2017, titled as *Randhir Singh Virk Versus Natinder Kaur*, filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Faridkot, is withdrawn from said Court and same is transferred to Court of learned District Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, who may retain the case with him or entrust the same to a Court of competent jurisdiction. Consequently, petition is allowed. Since main case has been allowed, pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
