This transfer application has been filed by the applicant-wife to transfer a petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the District Court, Jalandhar to a competent Court at Hoshiarpur.

The ground taken is that the applicant has a young child to look after. It is also not disputed that other cases are also pending between the parties in the Court at Hoshiarpur. Further the respondent is living at Adampur which is equally distanced from Hoshiarpur and Jalandhar.

On the comparative hardship test it would be appropriate if the divorce petition filed by the respondent at Jalandhar is transferred to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur. Ordered accordingly. The record be sent to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the District and Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur on 26.12.2018 who can try the case himself or mark the same to other competent court.

Consequently, the transfer application stands allowed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
