This order shall dispose of above mentioned two transfer applications.

TA No.65 of 2018 has been filed under Section 24 C.P.C. for transfer of the petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for restitution of conjugal rights titled as ***Harpinder Singh Vs. Manjit Kaur***

pending before the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Samrala to any competent Court at Rupnagar.

TA No.69 of 2018 has been filed under Section 24 Cr.P.C. for transfer of the petition for custody under Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act as well as under the provisions of Guardianship Act titled as *Harpinder Singh Vs. Manjit Kaur* pending before the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Samrala to any competent Court at Rupnagar.

The ground taken is that the applicant-Manjit Kaur has two minor children to look after and she has already filed an application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Rupnagar.

Counsel for the respondent states that actually the respondent is very keen to rehabilitate this marriage and that is why he has filed the petition for restitution of conjugal rights and for the custody of the children and prays that the matter be referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Rupnagar. I find favour in this argument and consequently transfer the matter filed by the respondent to the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Rupnagar.

It is directed that all the three cases which are now pending at Rupnagar would be decided by the same Court, and in the first instance the matter would be referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Rupnagar. Let the record be sent to the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Rupnagar. Parties through counsel are directed to appear on 28.12.2018 before Civil Judge (Senior Division), Rupnagar.
