This transfer application has been filed by the applicant-wife to transfer a petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the District Court, Jalandhar to a competent Court at Amritsar.

The ground taken is that another case filed by the applicant is pending in the Court at Amritsar. Further the matter was earlier referred to the Mediation Centre of this Court but the same has failed.

In my opinion, on the comparative hardship test it would be appropriate if the divorce petition filed by the respondent at Jalandhar is transferred to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar. Ordered accordingly. Application stands allowed. The record be sent to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar on 28.12.2018 who can try the case himself or mark the same to other competent court.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
