Petitioner has filed the present transfer application/petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of the petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled Narpal vs. Nisha which is pending before learned Additional District Judge, Rewari to the competent Court at District Panipat.

The marriage of the petitioner and respondent was solemnized on 29.4.2007. There is 10 years old minor child living with the petitioner. The petitioner has filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C which is pending.s

Learned counsel for the respondent has stated that he has no objection if the petition is allowed. In the circumstances, the petition is

allowed and petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as Narpal vs. Nisha which is pending before learned Additional District Judge, Rewari is withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to the Sessions Judge at District Panipat.

Let the record be sent there. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before District and Sessions Judge, Panipat on 18.12.2018. The learned District and Sessions Judge, Panipat may either decide the case himself or assign it to any Court of competent jurisdiction at Panipat.

The application stands disposed of.
