Respondent has not appeared despite service. He is proceeded against ex-parte.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing HMA/444/2017 filed under Section 13(1)(ia) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Ajay Khatri vs. Shiksha* pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Jhajjar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Hisar as nearby District.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that 3 cases i.e. a petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the present petitioner, petition under the the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005 and an application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. are pending at Hisar Courts.

In order to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties

are decided at one place, and the fact that none has come present to oppose the petition, petition bearing HMA/444/2017 filed under Section 13(1)(ia) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Ajay Khatri vs. Shiksha* pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Jhajjar is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned District Judge, Hisar, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
