This petition has been filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transferring the case under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as "Amandeep Singh Vs. Gurvinder Kaur" pending in the Court of Ld. District Judge cum Judge, Family Court, Faridkot to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Barnala.

The case of the petitioner is that she never contracted the marriage with the respondent. The petitioner even appeared before this Court in CRWP No.1237 of 2017 titled as 'Amandeep Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others' and had stated that no marriage was solemnized with the respondent.

The respondent has filed a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, which is pending before the learned District Judge, Faridkot. The petitioner is living in the house of her maternal uncle at Barnala. There is no one who can accompany the petitioner to Faridkot which is at a distance of 115 kms from the place of her residence.

The respondent has been served. However, neither on the previous date i.e. 13.08.2018 nor today is there any representation on his behalf.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this petition is allowed.

The case under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as "Amandeep Singh Vs. Gurvinder Kaur" pending in the Court of Ld. District Judge cum Judge, Family Court, Faridkot is withdrawn from that Court and transferred to Barnala. The District Judge Barnala may assign it to a competent Court at Barnala.
