This transfer application has been filed by the applicant-wife to transfer a petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the District Court, Jalandhar to a competent Court at Mukerian.

The ground taken is that the applicant is living in Talwara and the distance between Jalandhar and Talwara is around 90 Kms and that the applicant has also filed an application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. which is pending at Mukerian.

On the comparative hardship tests it would be appropriate if the petition filed by the respondent at Jalandhar is transferred to the same court where the application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is pending. Ordered accordingly. The record be sent to the said Court. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the said Court on 26.12.2018 who will endeavour that as far as possible the same date be given in both the cases so that unnecessary inconvenience is not caused to the parties.

Consequently, the transfer application stands allowed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
