Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Vinay Yadav vs Rupali Yadav*”, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurugram to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Rewari.

It comes out that three other cases between the parties are already pending at Rewari Courts.

In order to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties are tried at place, the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Vinay Yadav vs Rupali Yadav*”, pending in the Court

of learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Rewari, for disposal in accordance with law.
