This transfer application has been filed by the applicant-wife to transfer a petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the District Court, Faridkot to a competent Court at Jalandhar since there are two small children from the wedlock and the distance between Nakodar to Faridkot is around 115 kms.

On the comparative hardship test it would be appropriate if the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act filed by the respondent at Faridkot is transferred to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar. Ordered accordingly. The record be sent to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar on 24.12.2018 who can try the case himself or mark the same to other competent court.

Consequently, the transfer application stands allowed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
