Petitioner (wife) has filed the present petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as “**Vikram Kundu Vs. Pooja” filed by the respondent (husband) which is pending before learned District Judge Kurukshetra, to a court of competent jurisdiction at Sonapat.**

The marriage of the petitioner with the respondent was solemnized on 19.2.2017. There is no child from the said marriage.

Because of differences between the parties, the petitioner is residing with her parents at Kharkhoda (Sonapat). The petitioner has filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. which is pending at Sonapat. A case under Section 498-A, IPC against the respondent is pending before the Judicial Magistrate, Kharkhoda (Sonapat). Respondent has filed the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act at Kurukshetra.

It is the case of the petitioner that her father is serving in Border Security Force (B.S.F.) and remains posted at distant places. Younger brother of the petitioner stays at Delhi. There is no one in the family who can accompany the petitioner to attend the court proceedings at Kurukshetra.

Respondent, Vikram Kundu, has appeared in person. He states that he has no objection if the case is transferred from Kurukshetra to Sonapat.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this petition is allowed.

The petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as “Vikram Kundu Vs. Pooja” filed by the respondent (husband) which is pending before learned District Judge Kurukshetra is withdrawn from that court and transferred to Sonapat. The learned District Judge, Sonapat may assign it to a competent court.
