This transfer application has been filed by the applicant-wife to transfer a petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the District Court, Ludhiana to a competent Court at Jalandhar.

The ground taken is that two cases already filed by the applicant are pending in the Court at Jalandhar.

Counsel for the respondent states that fact of the matter is that the respondent is a businessman and frequent travelling will suffer his business. However, he has accepted that in the two cases filed by the applicant the respondent is going to Jalandhar to attend the proceedings.

On the comparative hardship tests it would be appropriate if the divorce petition filed by the respondent at Ludhiana is transferred to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar.

Ordered accordingly. The record be sent to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar on 27.12.2018 who can try the case himself or mark the same to other competent court.

However, the respondent is at liberty to move an application before the court/s to fix the case/s on the same date as far as possible.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
