This transfer application has been filed by the applicant-wife to transfer a petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the District Court, Gurugram to a competent Court at Rewari on the ground that three other cases between the parties are pending at Rewari.

Counsel for the respondent states that from the place of residence of the applicant, Rewari and Gurugram are almost at the same distance. Be that as it may, once it is not disputed that three other cases are pending at Rewari, it would be appropriate if the divorce petition filed by the respondent at Gurugram is transferred to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Rewari. Ordered accordingly. The record be sent

to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Rewari. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the District and Sessions Judge, Rewari on 07.01.2019 who can try the case himself or mark the same to other competent court.

Consequently, the transfer application stands allowed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
