This transfer application has been filed by the wife seeking transfer of the matrimonial case from Amritsar to a competent Court at Mohali.

It has been averred that the petitioner is living with her three children in Mohali and it is very difficult for her to face the divorce proceedings in Amritsar and that there are other cases between the parties which are pending at Mohali.

Counsel for the respondent is not in a position to deny the fact that the petitioner is living with her three children in Mohali and other cases are pending between the parties at Mohali.
