This transfer application has been filed by the applicant-wife to transfer a petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the Family Court, Ambala to a competent Court at Panchkula.

The ground taken is that the applicant has a minor child to look after.

In my opinion, on the comparative hardship tests it would be appropriate if the divorce petition filed by the respondent at Ambala is transferred to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Panchkula. Ordered accordingly. Transfer application stands allowed. The record be sent to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Panchkula. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the District and Sessions Judge, Panchkula on 07.01.2019 who can try the case himself or mark the same to other competent court.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
