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**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

This is an application for transfer of the petition filed by the husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the Court of Additional Civil Judge (SD) Dasuya District Hoshiarpur to any competent court at District Gurdaspur on the ground that the applicant is suffering from physical disability of lower limb to the extent of 60% and she has two minor children. It is difficult for her to attend the proceedings at Hoshiarpur. Counsel for the applicant states that other cases between the parties are also pending in Gurdaspur. Counsel for the respondent states that respondent is very keen to settle this dispute one way or other. Counsel for the applicant states that he would also have no objection if the dispute is settled one way or other.

In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to transfer the

petition titled as Sukhwinder Singh vs. Mamta Kumari pending in the Court of Additional Civil Judge (SD) Dasuya District Hoshiarpur to Civil Judge (Senior Division) Gurdaspur. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before Civil Judge (Senior Division) Gurdaspur on 19.12.2018 who in the first instance will refer the matter to Mediation Centre, Gurdaspur.

The application stands disposed of.
