This transfer application has been filed by the applicant-wife to transfer a petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the District Court, Jind to a competent Court at Hisar.

The ground taken is that the applicant has a 4½ years old child to look after and it is very difficult for her to travel 100 Km to Jind.

Counsel for the respondent oppose this application.

In my opinion, on the comparative hardship test it would be appropriate if the petition filed by the respondent at Jind is transferred to the Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Hansi. Ordered accordingly. The record be sent to the said Court. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the said Court on 28.12.2018.

Consequently, the transfer application stands allowed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
