 These are two applications for transfer. TA No.629-2018 is
 filed by wife against the husband praying that the divorce petition titled as
 Yogesh Chhabra vs. Daisy Mehtani filed by the husband at Fatehgarh Sahib
 be transferred to Hisar on the ground that no maintenance is being paid to
 her and it is very difficult for her to come Fatehgarh Sahib from Hisar.
 After that petition was filed the husband filed TA-910-2018 in which he

prayed that after he had filed divorce petition he had been transferred to Jalandhar and had prayed that divorce petition which he had filed either be transferred to Jalandhar or Chandigarh. The reason for preferring Chandigarh was that his father was a cancer survivor and he had to look after him. With regard to this transfer application counsel for the wife states that the prayer for transferring the divorce petition to Chandigarh is patently false because on the one hand the husband is saying that he wants to look after his parents but on the other hand, his parents have already disowned him. As regards the plea of transfer to Jalandhar it is case of the counsel for the wife that the husband cannot keep getting his divorce petition transferred from place to place expecting the wife to follow him from place to place.

In the circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to allow **TA-629-2018** and dismissed **TA-910-2018**. The divorce petition titled as Yogesh Chhabra vs. Daisy Mehtani filed before District and Sessions Judge, Fategarh Sahib is withdrawn from that Court and transferred to the Family Court Hisar. Let the record be sent there. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before Family Court, Hisar on 18.12.2018.
