Applicant Ritika, by way of moving application under reference, is seeking transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by her husband Ramesh Kumar against her, having title 'Ramesh Kumar vs. Ritika,' pending in the Court of learned District Judge/ Family Court, Bhiwani to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Sonipat.

Notice of the application was given to the respondent who as per office report, has been served through his brother-in-law and has appeared though counsel who does not oppose the request for transfer.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties besides going through the record.

I am of the view that the application calls for acceptance, the same

is accordingly allowed. The petition in question is ordered to be withdrawn from learned District Judge/ Family Court, Bhiwani and transferred to the learned District Judge, Sonipat for disposal in accordance with law. Learned District Judge, Sonipat may retain the petition on his board or assign it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear in the transferee Court on 24.01.2019. Copies of orders be sent to the Court of learned District Judge/ Family Court, Bhiwani as well as to the Learned District Judge, Sonipat for information and necessary compliance.
