

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that both parties belong to Barnala. However, respondent by mentioning that now he is residing in Village Jamalpur, Ludhiana, filed petition at Ludhiana Courts. The learned counsel for petitioner has also referred to petition filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. where Barnala address of both the parties is given.

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Considering said facts, petition No. HMA/1405/2017 dated 28.7.2017, titled as *Dharam Singh Versus Sandeep Kaur*, filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in Court of learned Additional District Judge, Ludhiana, is withdrawn from said Court and same is transferred to Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Barnala, for disposal in accordance with law. Consequently, petition is allowed. Since main case has been allowed, therefore, pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
