The present contempt petition has been filed for violation of the order dated 10.08.2018 stating therein that inspite of the investigation having been stayed, the respondents called the petitioner and his other family members to the police station for investigation. While supporting the said argument, learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon para 5 of the application of vacation of stay filed by the respondents wherein the respondents have admitted that the order of stay and further proceedings in the FIR has resulted in the stay of the investigation qua the other accused namely Gurmukh Pal Singh Sambhi and Ajit Singh Sambhi who had not even filed the petition and the application for vacation of stay is still pending.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner may have had a point but for the order dated 30.10.2018 passed by the same Bench vide which permission was granted to the respondents to proceed with the investigation

with a further direction to the petitioner to join the said investigation.

The said order has in fact clarified that there was no stay on the investigation. Accordingly, no contempt is made out.

Dismissed accordingly.
