This is revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of necessary directions to respondent No.5/Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Karnal to finalize the partition proceedings pending at a matured stage.

Brief facts are that the partition proceedings were initiated way back in the year 1999 and have been culminated in the issuance of Sanad Taksim on 15.04.2008. The respondents remained unsuccessful before the Authorities in hierarchy and Civil Writ Petition No.9623 of 2012 filed by them was also dismissed on 28.10.2014 by the High Court. In LPA No.1960 of 2014, no stay has been granted.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to

pass, there is no necessity of calling upon respondents at this stage, as no order prejudicial to the interests of anyone is being passed.

Since there is no stay in the pending LPA No.1960 of 2014, partition proceedings virtually culminated by passing Sanad Taksim, therefore, consequential order has to be passed by respondent No.5/Assistant Collector, 2nd Grade, District Karnal in accordance with law.

In view of above, the present revision petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.5/Assistant Collector, 2nd Grade, District Karnal to decide the pending proceedings at the earliest in accordance with law.
