Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 14.09.2017, directing the trial Court to try and conclude the matter within a period of four months and further directing it to submit a report with regard to the progress of the trial and reasons for delay if any, a report of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, dated 11.01.2018, has been received, to the effect that all prosecution witnesses have been examined and the statements of three of the accused were also recorded under Section 313 Cr.P.C., but the statements of accused Gurpreet Singh and Lalit Kumar could not be recorded as they did not appear when summoned by that court to do so.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that as a matter of fact as regards Gurpreet Singh, non-bailable warrants to secure his presence have been issued.

That being so, appropriate measures being take by the trial Court to secure the presence of the accused who obviously jumped bail, nothing

further remains to be seen by this Court.

Consequently, the case file be consigned to the record room.
