Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that while the petitioners do not oppose direction of the Ld. Court below to permit the minor child to meet his mother (respondent) on the designated days, still it would be appropriate, if the order is modified to the extent that the respondent may meet the minor child in Mohali, where he is studying presently, instead of the ADR Centre in the Courts in Jalandhar.

In the opinion of this Court, this prayer for modification could have been made by the petitioners before the Ld. Court below itself and it would be inappropriate at this stage to issue notice upon the respondent-mother for this limited purpose.

The matter is, thus, disposed off with liberty to the petitioners to first approach the Ld. Court below for appropriate modified relief as claimed in the present petition.
