Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the judgment passed by this Court on 22.02.2010 in *CWP-628-1999 Jagrup Singh V/s. State of Haryana and others* (Annexure P-2) the petitioner was granted benefit of the additional increments. This judgment has attained finality and the benefits were never released to the petitioner.

The petitioner then filed COCP-1150-2011 which was disposed of on 20.01.2012 (Annexure P-3) to do the needful within two months. Learned counsel for the petitioner now contends that he has not been granted full benefits. Keeping in view that this is a violation of the order of contempt petition, the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition to avail his remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
