The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.52, dated 03.06.2018, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC added lateron, at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 16.08.2018. The examination of PWs has not yet commenced and therefore, the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents and therefore, he may be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual submissions.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned/Duty Judicial Magistrate, at Sangrur.
