The petitioner is an accused in FIR No. 135 dated 06.08.2013 registered at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda under Section 18 of the NDPS Act, 1985. He was arrested and was granted anticipatory bail and was appearing regularly before the trial Court. However, on 20.10.2018, he could not appear due to some mis-communication with the counsel and, thus, his bail has been cancelled and non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is willing to surrender before the trial Court and seek regular bail.

Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let two copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

The petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on the next date of hearing i.e. 18.12.2018 and to move an application for grant of regular bail. In case such an application is filed, the trial Court is directed to allow the same subject to its satisfaction.
