Since as per the report of the Court below dated 30.08.2018, the petitioner has failed to comply with orders of this Court dated 17.05.2018, on the basis of which condition was imposed for depositing a sum of Rs.75,000/- and which the petitioner has failed to deposit till date. As is clear from the orders of anticipatory bail passed by this Court in CRM-M-14077 of 2017 on 17.5.2018 the Court has observed as follows:-

“Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 15.05.2017 is made absolute subject to the petitioner depositing a sum of Rs.75,000/- with the learned trial Court within three weeks from today. Needless to say the said deposit shall be without any prejudice to the rights of the petitioner.

It is reiterated that none of the observations made herein above are a reflection on the merits of the case and shall have no bearing on the trial.”

From the same, it is emphatically clear that the same was subject to the petitioner depositing a sum of Rs.75,000/- with the learned trial Court within three weeks.

In the light of this failure of the petitioner to comply with the orders and the undertaking which bars the petitioner from concession of anticipatory bail. Thus, having violated the same, orders dated 17.05.2018 granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner are hereby recalled.
